1. The **FESA Biathlon Alpencup (FESA BAC)** will take place in the 2023/24 season as independent event series. The regulations of the IBU Competition Rules, the IBU Regional Events and the FESA Biathlon Alpine Cup (as determined by the FESA BAC Committee) shall apply. The O.P.A Biathlon Alpine Cup consists of the following nations:
Andorra, Germany, France, Italy, Liechtenstein, Austria, Switzerland, Slovenia and Spain. The committee is composed of one representative from each nation.
2. The **announcement | invitation** is to be prepared by the organiser and sent to the NA of the Alpine countries. If necessary, a template can be requested from Gilda Jäger-Iseppi.
3. The **announcement** must be sent at least 8 weeks before the start of the event to gilda.jaeger-iseppi@swiss-ski.ch and majja.savolainen@ibu.at for approval.
4. The **timekeeping** for all competitions will be carried out by RaceTimePro. RaceTimePro links the start and result lists with SiwiData.

5. Accommodation

8. **Zeroing** is to be arranged in such a way that there is sufficient time for everyone to zero the rifles. If there are a large number of participants, the zeroing will start 20 minutes earlier and the targets will be changed twice.
9. For the **official training** and the **zeroing** for the competitions, the following shooting stand allocation is binding. The organising nation will be allocated the stands from stand 1, followed by the 2nd, 3rd and 4th organising nations. After the organisers, the remaining Alpine countries and then other participants will be allocated. The division will be **prone** from stand **1-15**. From stand **16-30 standing**, the **same division** as in stand 1-15 will take place again. This applies as far as the number of participants allows.

Example season 2024|25:

1st event: SLO, AUT, ITA, GER, SUI, ESP other nations ...
2nd event: AUT, ITA, GER, SUI, ESP, SLO, other nations ...
3rd event: ITA, GER, SUI, ESP, SLO, AUT other nations ...
4th event: GER, SUI, ESP, SLO, AUT, ITA other nations ...

10. The **competition fee** for the FESA Biathlon Alpine Cup has been set as follows:

11. At the FESA BAC events, **uniform wax** will be used. This will be done according to the protocols of the respective NF of the country where the competitions take place.

Ski preparation by Teams during Regional Events:

Not allowed to be used:

- Any kind of carbon-fluorine containing waxes
- High-performance waxes (e.g., powder, top finish liquid etc.)

Allowed to be used:

- Only base Fluor Free waxes officially supplied by the IBU (except Regional Events)
- Manual structure

Spot checks in wax cabins

In order to permanently monitor which products are used for ski-preparation, IBU officials can carry out spot checks in the wax cabins where also ski and wax-samples are taken.

12. The FESA BAC coordinator is responsible for the **coordination and support** of the organisers to ensure that the valid regulations are observed at the FESA BAC events. The coordinator is also a member of the competition jury without voting rights. If for any reason the FESA BAC Coordinator is not available, the respective member of the FESA BAC Committee of the organising nation is responsible for this matter.
13. **Jury for FESA Biathlon Alpencup**
- Chair: TD | CHKR by the NA of the organiser (IR, exceptions require the approval of the IBU)
- Members: Competition Director

2 team captains
FESA BAC Coordinator without voting rights.
14. All member federations of the IBU are **eligible to participate**. The announcement for the FESA Biathlon Alpine Cup shall be made for all classes. The division into classes and the course lengths must comply with the IBU rules. The organiser will be informed of any special regulations.
15. **Registration of competitors.** If the number of registered athletes allows it, there shall be no restrictions on the number of participants. If the number of participants from the guest nations does not allow the FESA Biathlon Alpine Cup event to run properly, a restriction on the number of starters shall be determined by the organiser together with the coordinator. Alpine Cup countries do not have a restriction of participants in a regular season.
16. **Participant registrations** (number of attendants and participants female and male) must be sent to the organiser **20** days before the day of arrival (to be determined in the announcement).
The registration by name must be made by the NA responsible **at the latest on Monday of the week of the event (specified in the announcement)** at <http://live.pflanzl.info/registrationservice>.
Non-Alpine Cup countries must register at timing@racetime.pro.
All athletes must be registered with the IBU no later than 14 days before the competition. (BASIC)
Control of entry list can be made **until 2 hours before the team captain meeting**.

17. **Entries not** submitted by the National Federations cannot be considered. Athletes who submit themselves are not eligible to compete, even if they are present at the venue. The team captain must be announced together with the entries. The organiser shall report the receipt of the entry to the National Federation.
18. The **entry fee** must be paid when collecting the start number.
19. **Special rules for the organisation of the FESA BAC events:**
It is possible for athletes to start one class higher than their age. During an event weekend the start is only possible in this one class. The classification, as well as the cup points for athletes, will only be awarded in the class in which they started.
20. **Sunday competitions:**
In the Sunday competitions there will be only one zeroing. The men and women, or vice versa, shall start one after the other, without a further zeroing. This applies as far as the number of participants allows.
21. **Results | Rankings FESA BAC:**
The result lists will be created by **RaceTimePro** immediately after the competition. They will be printed out by the organiser and handed out to the nations present. The result list is to be prepared in all classes. The classification will be done in accordance with the classification points in the WC. No strike result. Results as well as intermediate rankings and the final ranking of the FESA Biathlon Alpine Cup will be published on <https://winter.racetime.pro/biathlon> and on www.biathlonresults.com.
22. **All athletes** of the FESA Biathlon Alpine Cup Committee who are classified in the FESA BAC result lists will receive FESA Biathlon Alpine Cup points.
23. The **organiser** will provide the prizes for the FESA BAC competitions. Prizes will be awarded to the first "**THREE**" places in each class.
24. There will be **overall scores** for all classes. All points per class, from all competitions held, will be added together.

25. The **prices** for the overall winners, 1st to 3rd place in each class, will be provided by the FESA BAC and presented at the final event.
26. **Dates:** The dates for the coming season will be planned, if possible, at the final event and communicated to the IBU.
27. The **rotation** for the organisation of the competitions shall be determined at the annual final meeting.
